<b>Title</b>	Faroese for foreigners I
<b>ECTS</b>	10
<b>Prerequisites</b>	An upper secondary diploma or a corresponding certificate
<b>Level</b>	BA
<b>Purpose</b>	The purpose of the course is to give the student insight into the basics of Faroese grammar and language use. Emphasis will be on the four language skills: speaking, listening, reading and writing.
<b>Content</b>	Emphasis is on grammar and practical use.
<b>Learning and teaching approaches</b>	The course is organized by combining taught classes with distance education. The taught classes consist of 3-hour workshops 3 times during the course. In the beginning of the course; halfway through and towards the end. Via distance education students will get assignments every week. Internet access is necessary. Students outside the Faroe Islands will not attend classes.
<b>Learning outcomes</b>	On completion of the course, students who have passed Faroese for foreigners are expected to Demonstrate ability to master Faroese pronunciation Illustrate understanding of Faroese when reading and listening to non-complex conversations Use the most basic prepositions Apply pronouns Demonstrate ability to use the agreement system and to generate simple sentences
<b>Assessment method</b>	A four-hour written examination. Reference materials permitted.
<b>Examination</b>	Internal assessment
<b>Marking scale</b>	Pass / failed
